Call to Order: 6:30 p.m., City Hall Conference room

Discussion/Action Topics:

1. A review of City Ordinance 1147.02 and 1147.99 ---with information from 313.07. Political signs may be in private yards for 45 days and then must be taken down before being replaced. None are to be in the boulevards. The fine is up to \$100.
2. Discussion continued concerning people who leave discarded furniture and such at the curb. Whose responsibility is this? Are people unwilling to pay for these discards to be hauled away? This is not a City responsibility, but one of property owners and renters.
3. The committee will begin to peruse the existing ordinances to see if any need repealing, updating, re-writing, etc.
