Discussion/Action Topics:

A. From the President of Council:

---A request to peruse any local ordinances that the City may have regarding campers, boats, jet skis and/or boat trailers being parked in driveways or yards. Following a long discussion with much input from S.S.D. Colston, it was determined that there really isn't a major problem in the City. The present ordinances work as presented. A few places are in violation of city ordinances occasionally but these are handled by Mr. Colston or the police on a case by case basis: "Administration and police have this under control."

An email was sent to council members requesting the identification any problems within the city. None were noted to the L.R.O. Committee members.

Various other city ordinances were researched, including those of Toledo, Oak Harbor, Sandusky, Huron, Fremont, and Vermilion. All of these have no ordinances or very vague ones which don't address the President of Council's query. Mr. Colston, who has copies of the research, will look through the material..
