Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: 6:30 p.m., City Hall Conference room

Discussion/Action Topics:

A. From the President of Council:

"I wanted to have the LRO committee look into any ordinances that the City may have regarding campers, boats, jet skis and/or boat trailers being parked in driveways or yards."

A discussion of what is already an ordinance and/or do we need to add something and/or do we do nothing progressed. The Chief of Police, the Fire Chief, and Safety Service Director take care of the few problems which occur.

Mr. Colston said vehicles left on the street over 48 hours can be towed. Is the vehicle registered? Any non-legal vehicle can be towed immediately. A boat/jet skis trailer hooked to a truck is legal if licensed/registered. People may not connect water and electricity to campers and trailers parked on the street or in a driveway in order to turn them into a residence, even for a temporary time.

While there doesn't seem to be a major problem with campers, boats, jet skis and/or boat trailers being parked in driveways, streets, or yards this will be revisited with references from the O.R.C. Port Clinton is a resort area so we can expect parked recreational vehicles for periods of time in driveways, yards, and, perhaps, on the street. However, the owners must follow the City ordinances.

For problems with vehicles call Administrative Assistant Sandye Ostheimer at City Hall so the proper person can be notified for disposition.

Police Officer Nathan Edmonds is now the new "junk" officer for the City.

Meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m. on a motion by Jerry Tarolli, with a second by Beth Gillman, and 3-0 vote.
