WIC Clinic: promotes optimal nutrition for pregnant and breastfeeding Women, Infants and Children under age 5. Income eligibility and nutritional deficiencies are required.

WIC Clinic is available 6 times per month – call for an appointment.

Family Planning Clinic (Reproductive Health and Wellness): provides services for comprehensive family planning services. Charges are based on income and a sliding fee scale is available. Clinics are held weekly – call for an appointment.

Sexually Transmitted Diseases Clinic: provides Ottawa County residents with medical care for sexually transmitted diseases. Clinics are held weekly – call for an appointment.

Immunization Clinic: provides a variety of immunizations for infants, children and adults 7 times per month at 3 clinic locations in Ottawa County. At this time, immunizations are available at no cost to infants and children who are residents of Ottawa County. Call for an appointment.

Bureau for Children with Medical Handicaps (BCMh): provides case management and assessment for children with medical handicaps up to age 21. There is no charge for this service. Call the health department to speak to a BCMh Nurse about your child's health problems.

TB Clinic: TB testing is provided weekly at the health department offices. The cost is \$10.00. This is a walk-in clinic.
