**ORDINANCE 16-15**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN ADVISORY ELECTION QUESTION TO BE PLACED ON A CITY-WIDE BALLOT AT THE NEXT SCHEDULED GENERAL ELECTION WITHIN THE CITY AND REQUESTING THAT THE OTTAWA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS PLACE THIS ISSUE ON THE BALLOT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mr. Below made a motion, seconded by Mrs. DeFreitas to waive the required three readings for Ordinance 16-15. Results of a voice roll call are as follows: Snider, yes; Below, yes; Sarty, yes; Gillman, yes; Tarolli, no; DeFreitas, yes and Phillips, yes. With a 6-1 vote, the required three readings for Ordinance 16-15 have been waived.

Mr. Below made a motion, seconded by Mrs. Gillman to retain the emergency clause for Ordinance 16-15.
