

ORDINANCE 14-16

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO PURCHASE A 2001 INTERNATIONAL DUMP TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City is in need of purchasing a used dump truck for its Service Department; and

WHEREAS, Perkins Township, Erie County, Ohio, has a 2001 International 4700D, dump truck which it is offering to sell to the City; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Safety and Service had the dump truck inspected and has recommended the purchase of the dump truck.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Safety and Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement and to purchase a 2001 International 4700 D dump truck from the Trustees of Perkins Township, Erie County, Ohio, for an amount of not more than \$13,000.00.

Section 2. To pay for said purchase there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$13,000.00 from the Municipal Purposes Fund, Account No. 241-0441-54200.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its Committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or Committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to allow the City to acquire the truck and place it in service prior to the vehicle being sold to someone else.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
